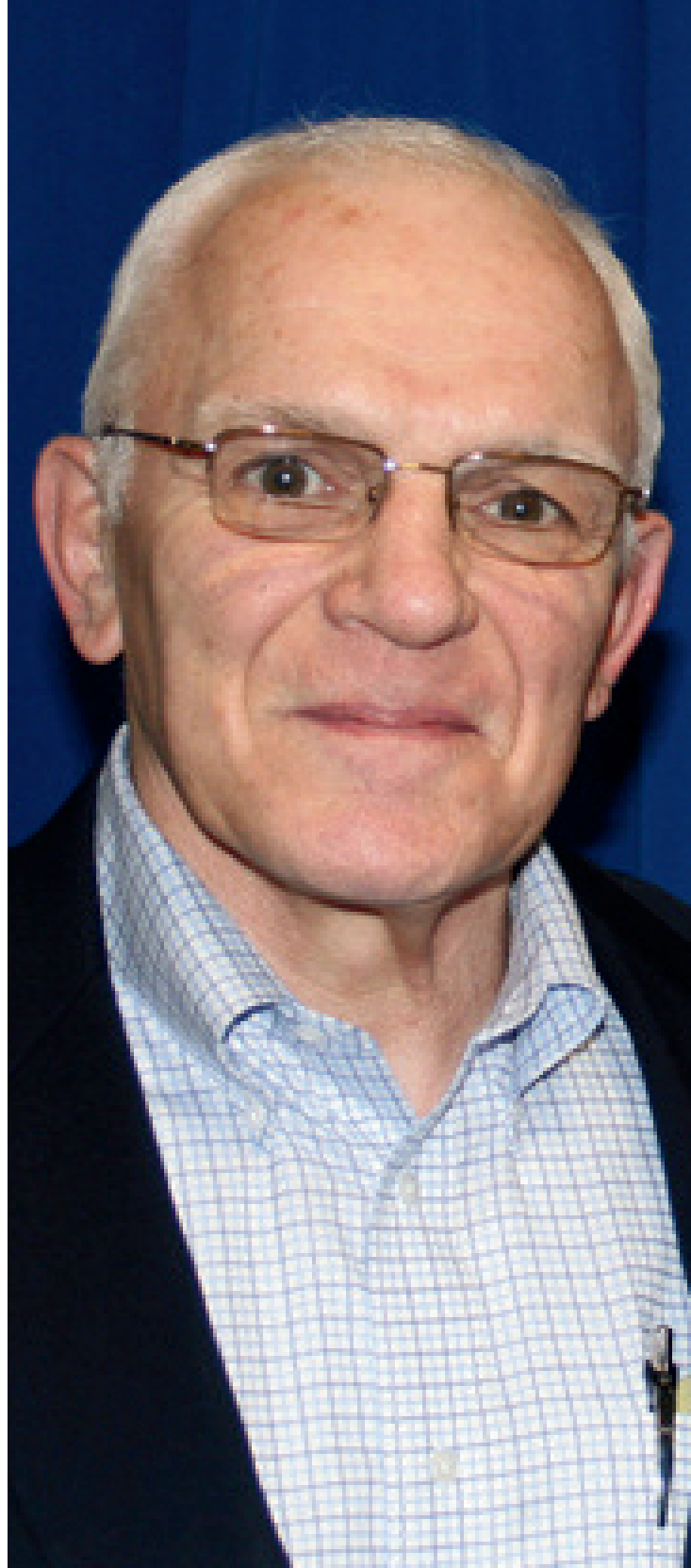
As we look to the future, I am inspired by the impact we can achieve together. Your continued partnership enables us to respond to emerging needs, innovate our programs and deepen our commitment.

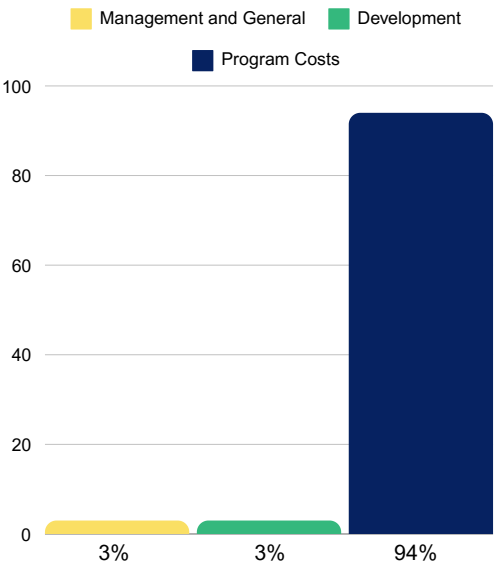

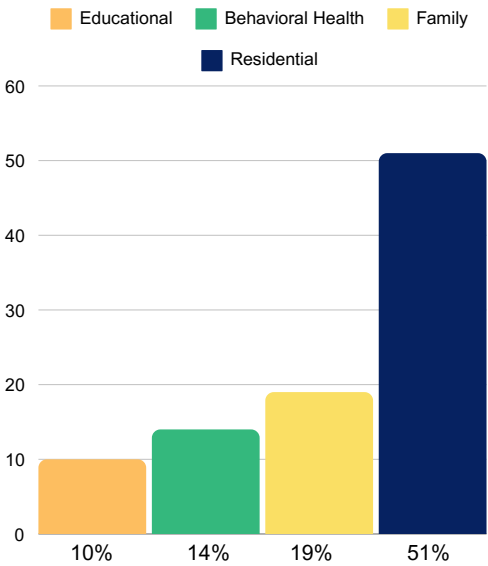
Funding Sources

FY2024

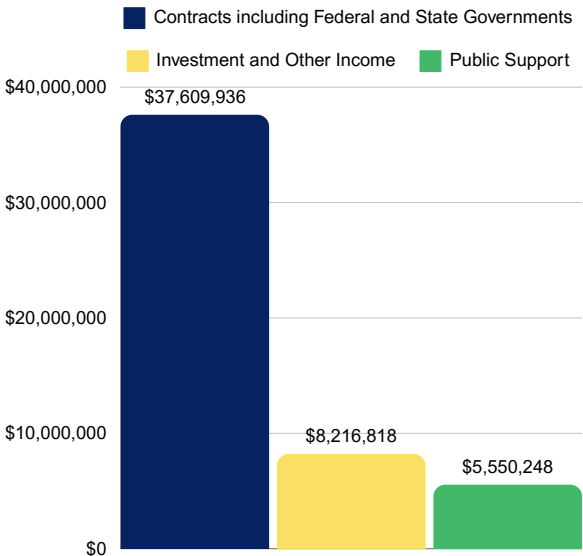
Total Expenses - \$48,603,837

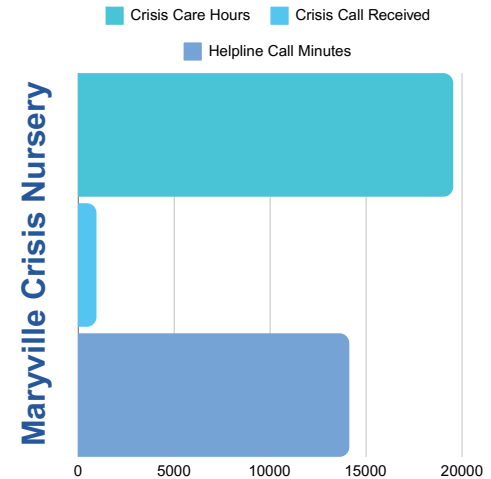
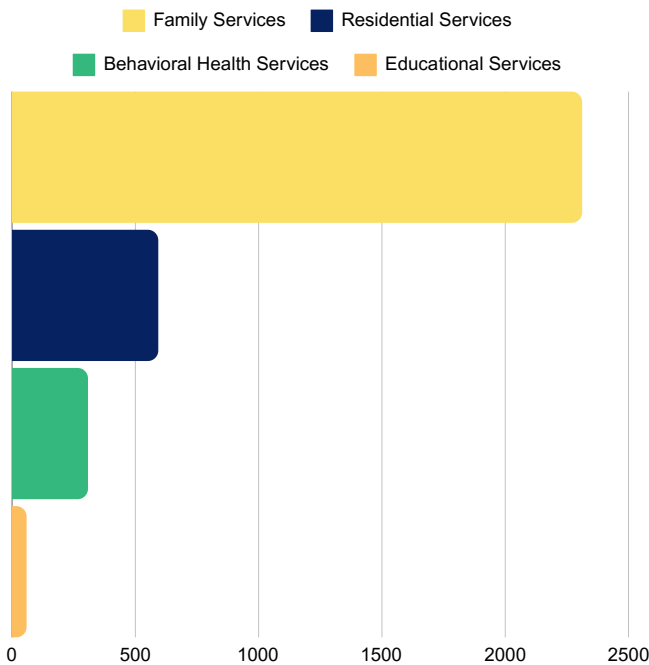

- The **Maryville CYO 8th Annual Golf Classic Invitational** held in July at The Preserve at Oak Meadows Golf Course (Addison) helped fund Maryville's Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) sports program.
- The support from golfers, sponsors and donors at the **29th Annual IPGA-Maryville Gleason Cup Invitational** in August at Evanston Golf Club in Skokie served hundreds of children, youth and young adults.

Maryville's golf program continues its growth and outreach. It empowers golf skills, vocational training and personal development opportunities.

- One of Maryville's most valued partnerships is with the **Chicago Police Department**. In April, they held successful donation drives for the Nursery for Child Abuse Awareness Month.

The Crisis Nursery received over \$10,000 in donations from the 9th, 10th, 16th, 18th and 25th Districts. The donations were used in the program and benefitted many parents whom we provide case management services throughout the year.

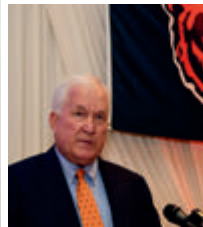

We have seen a significant increase in participation and outcomes and the year was filled with inspiring stories. Yet, as much as numbers and statistics reflect our progress, they do not fully capture the profound impact of our staff's care—how lives are transformed and futures shaped.

Maryville has continued to serve more people than before despite the lingering challenges brought on by the pandemic.

Adapting to Changing Needs

While some programs have decreased participation due to changing community needs, Maryville remains committed to evolving with those needs. Although some programs have

changed their direction, Maryville has adapted and served children and families in the most effective ways to answer their needs.

The Growth of Mother's Recovery Home Network

One growth area has been our Mother's Recovery Home Network, a critical service providing sober living environments for mothers working to rebuild their lives while parenting their children.

Maryville has led the way in Illinois in offering these services and demand is growing. St. Monica and St. Josephine Bakhita Homes have proven to support mothers successfully. St. Monica is at capacity after a significant decline in population during the pandemic, while St. Josephine, which opened during the pandemic, is expanding.

Family Behavioral Health Clinic's Recovery

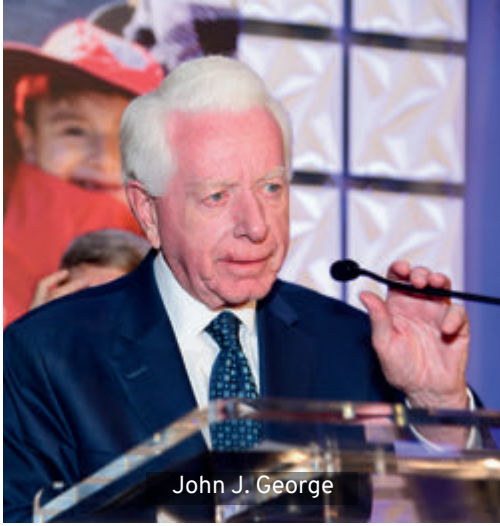
Our Family Behavioral Health Clinic (FBHC) has also made great strides. This year, we are continuing to grow our capacity to meet the mental health needs of our communities in Des Plaines and Chicago. We are committed to expanding these services further in the coming year.

Walsh Academy's Continued Growth

Walsh Academy has remained steady and resilient after a year of change. The academy is well-positioned for growth with a new name and building designed for expansion in a new location. We welcomed more students and provided them with opportunities to learn, grow and develop for a successful future.

Celebrating Walsh Academy's first graduation at the new Niles campus

Eight students from Charles H. Walsh Sr. Academy & Career Tech High School marked a significant milestone on May 31, 2024. They became the first graduates of Walsh Academy, celebrating its inaugural graduation ceremony at its new location and under its new name.

Sean Madden, Maryville Board's vice chair, was the commencement speaker.

Walsh Academy (formerly Jen School) relocated to its new campus at 6935 W. Touhy Avenue in Niles from Des Plaines in the fall of 2023.

"I am excited to be part of this momentous chapter in our students' lives," said Dr. Ann Craig, Ed.D., principal and Maryville director of educational services. "Our faculty and staff are proud of what our students have achieved. Their resilience and hard work have paid off and we cannot wait to see what the future holds for them," Dr. Craig said.

Future classes, according to Dr. Craig, would include drafting and computer-aided design, electrical, plumbing, welding, HVAC and health science.

Walsh Academy, awarded by the National Association Special Education Teachers School as a School of Excellence for 11 consecutive years, fosters strong partnerships with contractors, union organizations and school districts to create valuable internships and job opportunities for students in their communities.

Dr. Craig reminded the graduates of their accomplishments, resilience and unwavering spirit.

"You leave Walsh Academy not just as graduates but as accomplished leaders, critical thinkers, and individuals oozing with potential. Go and embrace the world," she said.

Successful discharge highlights CHC's exceptional quality of care

A successful discharge of a young boy is one of the highlights at the Children's Healthcare Center this fiscal year. The little boy was only 18 months old and facing significant health challenges when he arrived at the CHC. He was premature, ventilator-dependent, malnourished and very sick.

He was transferred from another facility and initially brought to a local hospital before being referred to CHC. In a desperate situation, the hospital reached out to CHC for assistance in caring for the young boy. The CHC staff quickly sprang into action and admitted him in March 2020.

When the young boy was admitted, his condition required specialized pediatric care and a personalized treatment plan. From day one, the CHC team worked tirelessly to provide him with the medical attention he needed.

The child's progress is a testament to the exceptional medical care provided at CHC, as well as the unwavering dedication and compassion of staff.

Over the next three years, the staff successfully weaned him off the ventilator, removed his tracheostomy and enrolled him in school. He left CHC walking, talking and thriving just two days before Christmas to join a "perfect foster family," according to Helene Pochopien, CHC's director of nursing.

His discharge represents more than just the conclusion of a treatment process – it is a powerful symbol of hope and resilience, not only for this child but for all the families CHC serves. When the young boy was discharged, the CHC team took immense pride in their positive impact, knowing they had helped transform a young life.

The CHC is a Maryville transitional healthcare facility for children, ages birth to 21, with complex medical needs. It provides hospital-to-home support and care for medically fragile children and their families so that they can safely return home, avoiding unnecessary hospitalizations.

It works in partnership with the children's medical team, which includes doctors, specialists, nurses, therapists and social



workers from hospitals. Grants received by CHC provide for physical, massage and music therapies and developmental play.

Family involvement is essential at CHC. Support services such as parent education, respite care and counseling empower families to navigate the challenges of caring for a medically fragile child. Additionally, the CHC staff provides thorough training to families and caregivers on using specialized equipment, which is then sent home with the child upon discharge.

CHC is making a lasting impact on the lives of children and families, empowering every child to thrive despite the challenges they face and ensuring they receive the care, support and resources they need.

National program empowers Maryville mothers with essential parenting tools



Ten women successfully completed the Chicago Parent Program series, with eight receiving their certificate of completion during a graduation ceremony at the Maryville Crisis Nursery on May 24, 2024.

Four of the women who graduated were from the Maryville Academy Mother's Recovery Home Network. The others are mothers who have used the Crisis Nursery.

The three Maryville staff worked collaboratively to motivate, encourage and mentor the parents. The parents at the graduation ceremony became

emotional as they were celebrated and honored for their dedication, hard work and commitment to learning and growing as parents. They shared how much the certificate means to them.

"I learned different tools to be able to deal with my children and their behaviors," said S.M., one of the mothers who graduated.

The Chicago Parent Program is a national, evidence-based program designed to address the needs of parents raising children, 2-8 years old, in underserved communities.

This training program has improved parenting skills and confidence while reducing challenging behaviors in young children. The course is held twice a week for six weeks.

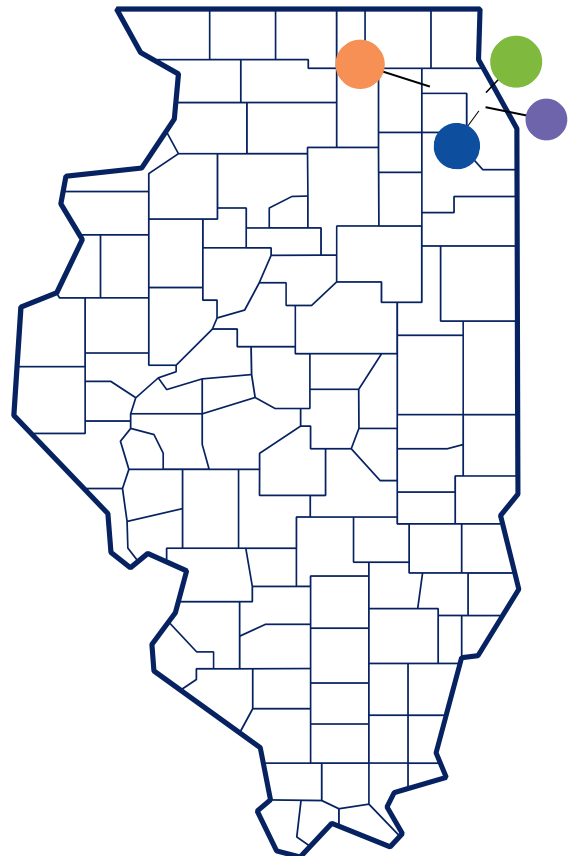

Gifts of stock that have been held longer than a year are tax deductible for the present fair market value of the stock and not subject to capital gain taxes.

Gifts from Retirement Accounts

If you are 70 ½ or older, you may directly transfer your required minimum distribution or up to \$100,000. Although a tax deduction is not available, the transfer will not count as taxable income.
